



General Poster guidelines

Poster presentations will be developed in the Bioclimatic Room in one physical board reserved for each author with the corresponding code (PS-numbers). Presentations are organized in 4 poster sessions of one hour of duration. Each session is scheduled on a specific day at a specific time (from 12:30 to 13:30 or from 18:00 to 19:00) indicated in the symposium program available in the website of the symposium (<http://www2.ual.es/horchimodel2021/Program.html>).

Poster boards are in vertical format, the recommended size is DIN A0, measuring 841 mm in width and 1189 mm in height.

The assigned number in the symposium program (PSn.m) will be included in the poster and will be on the corresponding board. The first part of this number (n) indicates the topic of the poster and the second part (m) the order number of the poster on that topic.

If help is needed with poster printing, we could print at University of Almería (no charge). In this case, please send your .pdf file of poster by 21st June via email (horchimodel2021@ual.es).

Conference assistants in the poster area may help authors in putting up or taking down their posters.

Pins that will be on the boards themselves will be used to hold the posters. In case there are missing pins, consult our staff in the bioclimatic room where the poster exhibition will take place or in the welcome desk at the hall of *Aulario* II building next to the Auditorium.

The authors must be present in the poster exhibition room during the hour of duration of the session to which their poster has been assigned. The authors are expected to be present next to their poster to be able to explain the work done to attendees who are interested in it.
