PARTICIPATION IN THE VIRTUAL CONFERENCE (EDUHEM2018)

The format of the on-line modality keeps some differences with the on-site modality, the follow up provides some relevant aspects of the virtual conference.

Virtual Conference through Moodle Platform

- The virtual conference will take place within the Moodle platform in which participants have been registered. If somebody have problems with access to the platform, contact with infocpc@ual.es
- All main talks will be show by streaming from this platform.
- On the Moodle platform, all virtual communications and posters will be posted, both in video format and in poster format. Each of them will be associated with a forum, in which comments and pertinent questions will be made. In this way we seek to emulate the participation in the face-to-face communication tables.

Virtual participation in the conference

- There is no programme or schedule that organizes communications chronologically. Due to the time difference of the participants, the period to interact virtually will take place during the three days of the congress, ending on June 23. This means that the participants can interact at any time of the conference
- To certify the virtual participation, each participant will be asked to (1) have their virtual presentation and / or poster hold on the Moodle platform (2) make at least one comment to any of the presentations post on in the Moodle platform, and lastly (3) to answer the questions or comments made in its own presentation.
- At the end of the conference, the digital production centre will establish a relationship with all the interactions of each one of the participants. If all of the above requirements have been achieved, certificates of attendance and communication will be sent to your emails during the next two weeks.
- The Moodle platform will remain open after the end of the conference date.

Information on How to submit virtual presentations

Virtual presentation: description

- Participants with oral communications must record a video or a power-point presentation with audio, being the total playing time of about 5-10 minutes. Each presentation should include an introduction, objectives, methodology, results and *conclusions.* Those videos will be sent to Moodle platform or to eduhem18al.es
- Participants with poster must send their poster in JPG of PDF format

How to send a link to the video in the Moodle Platform?

To avoid overloading the platform, participants should send a link to the video via Dropbox or Google Drive to the Moodle Platform. That means uploading in the "virtual presentation" section the link produced by Dropbox o Google drive. Links must be generated in public mode.

How to answer questions during the conference?

At the beginning of the conference one forum related to each video will be created. Each participant will be prepared to answer questions from other participants. Similarly, participants should ask their doubts to the communications of other partners.
