

General Poster guidelines

Poster presentations will be developed in the **Hall** of the building *Ciencias de la Salud* in one **physical board** reserved for each author with the corresponding code (PS-numbers).

Presentations are organized in **10 poster sessions** of 30 minutes of duration. Each session is scheduled on a specific day at a specific time (from 12:30 to 13:00 h, from 15:30 to 16:00 h or from 17:30 to 18:00 h) indicated in the symposium program available in the website of the symposium

(https://www2.ual.es/greensys2025/Program.html).

Poster boards are in vertical format, the recommended size is **DIN A0**, measuring **841 mm in width and 1189 mm in height**.

Conference assistants in the poster area may help authors in putting up or taking down their posters.



The assigned number in the symposium program (**PSn.m**) will be included in the poster and will be on the corresponding board. The first part of this number (n) indicates the session of the poster and the second part (m) the order number of the poster on that session.

Pins that will be on the boards themselves will be used to hold the posters. In case there are missing pins, consult our staff in the Hall of the building *Ciencias de la Salud*, where the poster exhibition will take place, or in the welcome desk at the hall of *Paraninfo* where plenary sessions will be developed.


Authors in attendance time

The authors must be present in the poster exhibition room during the hour of duration of the session to which their poster has been assigned. The authors are expected to be present next to their poster to be able to explain the work done to attendees who are interested in it.

The presenters who have applied for the **ISHS Young Minds Awards** will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee during their poster session to determine the winner. Authors must be present at their session to answer any questions the reviewers may have.
